## QUALIFIED DOMESTIC RELATIONS ORDER FOR MILITARY PENSION This order is entered this day of , 20 [after a hearing] [by stipulation of the parties. This order is intended to divide a service member's Disposable Retired Pay as that term is used in the Uniformed Services Former Spouses Protection Act, 10 U.S.C. Section 1408, and to grant the service member's former spouse a survivor benefit plan. 1. Parties. - 4. Relationship of Former Spouse to Service Member. The Former Spouse is the former spouse of the Service Member.
